

Information about a call for one three-year position of *Ricercatore a tempo determinato B* (Tenure-track Assistant Professor) in Philosophy of Language

(s.c. I I/C4 Estetica e filosofia dei linguaggi (Aesthetics and Philosophy of Language) - s.s.d. MFIL/05 Filosofia e teoria dei linguaggi (Philosophy and Theory of Languages))

Deadline: June 7, 2018

The Department of Philosophy and Educational Sciences at the University of Turin, Italy, is searching for candidates for a position of *Ricercatore a tempo determinato, tipo B* (=tenure-track Assistant Professor). The position is for three years; tendentially, upon receiving the *abilitazione* (=national habilitation) within that period, the position will be permanent.

The candidate is expected to publish in the best international journals and to contribute to the research activities of the interdepartmental Center for Logic, Language and Cognition (LLC), www.llc.unito.it. The teaching load is 90h per year; overall didactic activities (including tutoring and students' supervision) are 350h per year. Mastery of Italian is required.

Formal admission requisites: 1) Italian PhD or equivalent title issued in Italy or abroad (in such a case, officially certified within the hiring date); 2) three years (altogether) of either research contracts, or research grants, or even post-doc scholarships issued in Italy or elsewhere.

As to substantive requisites, applicants should

- pursue an original and innovative research program in analytically-oriented philosophy of language, with particular reference to themes in semantic and pragmatics;
- have a strong track record of publications at the international level;
- be committed to their teaching, including the supervision of BA and MA students;
- be involved in and promote applications for external funding at the local, national and international level.

Annual gross salary: around 45000€.

Along with the application, the candidate must provide (as printed in case a) and b), as a .pdf in case c): i) copy of her ID; ii) cv of her scientific and didactic activity (UE citizens may use the form B (in Italian) available on the website; non-UE citizens must provide an officially certified translation) iii) titles either in original, or in an officially certified copy, or (for UE citizens) in a copy accompanied by a personal declaration of conformity to the original, to be made by using the aforementioned form B; iv) publications (max 12) - for UE citizens, they may be provided in a copy accompanied by a personal declaration of conformity to the original, to be made by using the aforementioned form B.
